

Nursery Rearing of Indian Major Carps

Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Mamnoor conducted a five days training programme on Nursery Rearing of Indian Major Carps from 24.03.2025 to 28.03.2025 which was sponsored by the National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB) and ICAR-ATARI Zone-X. The training programme was inaugurated on 24.03.2025 by Dr. N. Rajanna, Programme Coordinator & Head of KVK, Mamnoor along with other KVK scientists. The training programme included topics such as site selection, pond construction, pre-stocking pond management, natural breeding, hypophysation techniques, spawn collection from natural sources, quality seed selection, packing and transportation methods, water quality management, feeding techniques, disease management the importance of minerals, seasonal precautions and nutritional deficiency management in nursery fish ponds. The Valedictory Programme was held on 28.03.2025 for which Smt. A. Nagamani, District Fisheries Officer attended as the chief guest. While addressing trainees she urged to take up aquaculture as an alternative to agriculture and gave away the certificates to trainees and also released a training manual on Nursery Rearing of Indian Major Carps. A total of 25 participants including fishermen and women cooperative members, actively participated in the training programme.
